Pre-Conditions for Applications for Selection

To be considered for selection, all athletes within the nominated crew must have fulfilled the following conditions by 30 March 2010. Those athletes who have met the below conditions may submit an expression of interest to Yachting Australia prior to 31 March 2010.

- Be current members of Yachting Australia
- Have demonstrated national and international level performances in the past 12 months in Match Racing.

FISU Eligibility Requirements

Please note that to be eligible for selection, athletes must also meet the FISU eligibility criteria. It is the athlete's responsibility to establish that he/ she meets all FISU and AUS eligibility requirements. Those requirements can be summarised as follows:

- be an Australian Citizen;
- be at least 17 and less than 28 years of age on 1 January 2010;

and be either:

- enrolled and currently studying a diploma or higher courses at a university, TAFE* (*conditions apply) or other tertiary institution (please note deferred students are not eligible for selection); or
- have graduated from a university in the year immediately prior to the event (ie: graduated after July 2009).

Athletes recommended for selection by Yachting Australia, will need to complete and submit to AUS the FISU eligibility certificate. For more information please contact Adam Abbott, AUS High Performance Coordinator on email: adam.abbott@unisport.com.au or phone: (07) 3876 2610.

Event Details

The event will consist of one mixed tournament followed by semi-finals and finals. The boats (J 24) will be supplied by the Organizing Committee and drawn every day or at each stage.

Crews will consist of **four or five (4 or 5) persons** with a maximum of 350Kgs (men or mixed crew or entirely female). Excepting a CISCA decision, the skipper cannot be replaced during the championship.

Certificate of Academic Eligibility

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Australian University Sport (AUS) currently applies the following regulations when selecting representative teams to participate in FISU competitions:

a) FISU Regulations 5.2.1

Only the following may participate as competitors in a FISU Sporting Event:

- i) Students who are currently enrolled and proceeding towards a diploma or higher at a university or similar institute whose status is recognised by the appropriate national academic authority of their country (e.g. the Australian Government Department of Education).
- ii) Former students of the institutions mentioned in (i) who have completed their academic degree/diploma in the 12months preceding the event. (Must provide copy of Graduation Certificate)

b) FISU Regulations 5.2.3

All competitors must satisfy the following conditions.

- i) be a national of the country they represent (therefore hold a full 10 year Australian passport)
- ii) be at least 17 and less than 28* years of age on January 1st in the year of the event
* With the exception of Basketball who must be at least 17 and less then 24 years of age on January 1st in the year of the event

c) Students studying abroad are eligible for selection provided they satisfy FISU regulations 5.2.1 and 5.2.3, including the institution being recognised by that Governments academic authority.
