1. RULES

Thursday night, no dinner as per above, but there will be a Welcome Night with a variety of pizzas and finger food. Sunday evening, there will be a Presentation of Awards function, and this will either be a buffet meal or a selection of finger foods, party pies, sausage rolls, fish goujons etc.

The Sunday evening Presentation Function will commence reasonably early after the completion of racing to accommodate teams wishing to fly home later that evening.

The meal package is not optional.

It will be provided to competitors, registered team coaches and team managers, and team supporters registered for the event.

Payment will be required with the team entry payment which shall include a list of competitors, registered team coaches and team managers, and team supporters attending the event.

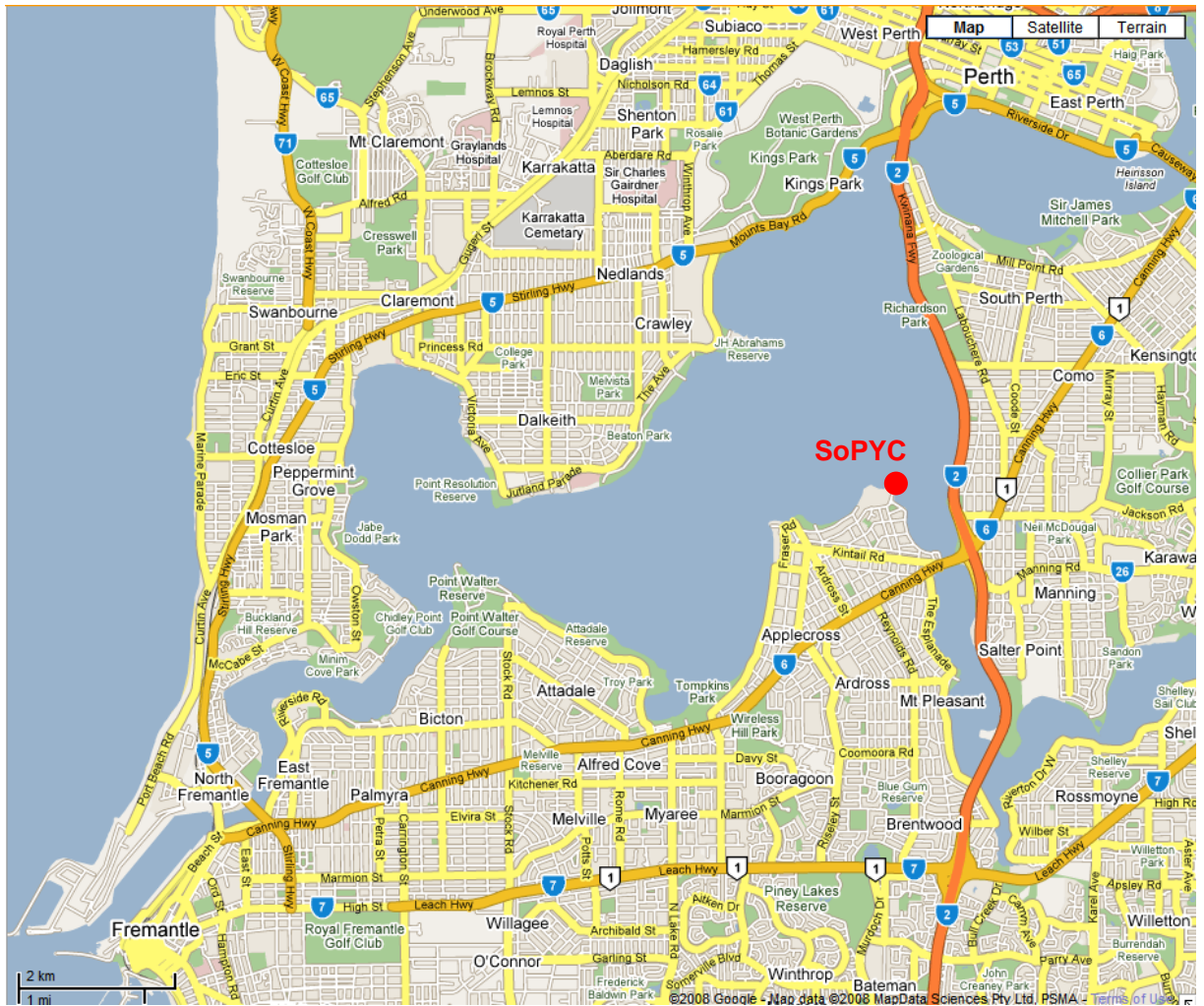
